Action	No.	Resolution Title	Description
WITHDRAWN	<u>1</u>	<u>Name Change of Insurance Committee to Benefits Committee</u>	Requires amending the Constitution by renaming the Association's Insurance Committee to Benefits Committee and, broadening its scope to include all benefit programs.
APPROVED	<u>2</u>	<u>Reducing Expenses in Production of Focus Magazine</u>	Requires that Resolutions for consideration at an Annual Conference be published in their final form on the official CSEA website and the website be prominently advertised in the Annual Conference edition of the official publication.
DEFEATED	<u>3</u>	<u>Term Limits for School Board Members</u>	Requires that CSEA sponsor legislation to limit the term of elected school board members to a maximum of 12 years.
WITHDRAWN	<u>4</u>	<u>Retiree Affiliate Membership</u>	Grants voting rights for all purposes and eligibility to hold offices within the Retiree Unit to retired staff Affiliate members with twenty-five (25) years or more of service
APPROVED	<u>5</u>	<u>Tenure for Recreational Occupational Program Instructors</u>	Requires that CSEA sponsor legislation to allow Regional Occupation Program (ROP) instructors to be able to include their years teaching ROP courses as part of the calculation for tenure.
DEFEATED	<u>6</u>	<u>California Residence for Board Members</u>	Requires amending the Constitution to create an additional eligibility requirement of residency in the State of California to run for, and remain in, an elected Association Officer and Area Director position.
DEFEATED	<u>7</u>	<u>Mandatory Rest Breaks for Classified Non-Exempt Employees/Alignment of Rest Breaks with Industrial Welfare Commission Regulations</u>	Requires that CSEA sponsor legislation to add the Industrial Welfare Commission (IWC) Wage Order language regarding rest breaks to the Education Code that authorizes rest periods at the rate of ten (10) minutes per four (4) hours.
